Matachewan First Nation Species at Risk Inventory Field Worker

Matachewan First Nation is currently accepting applications for a Field Worker for our Species at Risk Inventory within our First Nation boundaries.

The position will have the following responsibilities:

- Travel within our First Nation boundaries to document any Species at Risk or animals/plants of concern to MFN.
- Maintain any equipment used for this project.
- Follow safety protocols and wear PPE while in the field.
- Project will run from August 15th, 2022 to June 30, 2023.

Activities:

- Travel as much as possible of the First Nation over 5 to 6 days a month without disturbing the wildlife.
- Use an app, GPS, and/or camera to record all sightings.
- Document any traditional/medicinal plants or plants of interest.
- Document any dens/nests of Species at Risk (You will receive a full list)
- Pay special attention to bat habitats and sightings.

Qualifications:

- Able to walk a lot.
- Able to use a digital camera.
- Knowledge of safety while in the woods.
- Knowledge of the lands and habitats within the FN borders would be an asset.

Remuneration:

- You will be paid up to \$250 per day on a schedule agreed to by your supervisor.
