

Instructions to Vote

Through the ***Matachewan First Nation Treaty Land Entitlement Settlement Agreement, dated for reference August 25, 2022***, Chief and Council have provided Matachewan First Nation Eligible Voters two voting methods to cast a ballot on the Land Entitlement Settlement Agreement:

1. Online Voting
2. In-Person Voting

The instructions for each voting method are provided below and Eligible Voters may choose **only one** of the methods.

ONLINE VOTING

Online voting will be available 24 hours per day starting at 9:00 am. on Monday, September 5, 2022, and ending on Saturday, October 1, at 8:00 pm.

How to Vote Online using Simply Voting (From any computer, tablet, iPad or smart phone)

Visit the Simply Voting landing page <https://matachewanfirstnation.simplyvoting.com> to register with and initiate the Online voting process with your First Nation.

Have your 10 Digit Status Card Number (Registry Number, beginning with 219) & Date of Birth ready.

- Follow voting instructions listed on Simply Voting.

IN PERSON VOTING (Official Voting Day)

The Official Voting Day will take place on Saturday, October 1, 2022, from 9:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. at the Matachewan FN log building, Matachewan First Nation, ON P0K 1M0

Please bring one piece of **ID with your name and picture.**

You will need to declare your intent to vote; forms will be available at the polling station.
