**Overview of Responsibilities**

The Family Cultural Worker provides a traditional direct one to one support to parents in their home or in a group setting. Services include educating parents about childcare and child development; advocacy for parents/families; encourage nurturing behaviour and interaction between parents and their children; and assisting parents and families in accessing relevant community resources. The Family Cultural Worker functions with the policy and procedures of Matachewan First Nation.

**Knowledge Requirements**

- Knowledge of Matachewan First Nation programs and services
- Respect for, sensitivity towards as well as knowledge and understanding of First Nation culture, traditions, and the Seven Grandfather Teachings
- Knowledge of First Nation service delivery, customs, and traditions in responding to child welfare
- Knowledge of external services and service agencies
- Willing to attend training workshops, and conferences
