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### **ABOUT THE OPPORTUNITY**

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Based at the Detour Lake Mine site, we currently have an exciting opportunity for a **Emergency Response Specialist** on our **Asset Protection team** reporting to the Asset Protection Superintendent.

Detour Lake is the second largest gold producing mine in Canada with the largest gold reserves and substantial growth potential. The open pit mine is located in northeastern Ontario, approximately 300 kilometres northeast of Timmins and 185 kilometres by road northeast of Cochrane, within the northernmost Abitibi Greenstone Belt. The mine is situated in the area of the historic Detour Lake open pit/underground mine operated by Placer Dome which produced 1.8 million ounces of gold from 1983 to 1999. The Detour Lake operation has a mine life of approximately 22 years with an average gold production of 659,000 ounces per year.

The **Emergency Response Specialist** is accountable for day to day operations at the Detour Lake Mine site.

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## **RESPONSIBILITIES**

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Your responsibilities will include:

- Provide effective and efficient leadership for the Emergency Response Team
- Respond to all emergencies listed, but not limited to: Airport Rescue Firefighting, Hazmat, Medical, Fire, Technical Rescue, Motor Vehicle Accidents, Alarm investigations.
- Act as incident command or aid in support of the volunteer officers
- Establish and prioritize departmental goals and objectives.
- Ensure they safety and well being of all emergency response team personnel and site personnel
- Preparation of administrative reports, training records and data input
- Build, maintain and update the design of departmental SOP's & SOG's
- Act as the role of Training officer to plan, teach and implement emergency response courses & training sessions
- Complete pre-incident planning for emergency response efforts
- Complete fire code and building safety inspections around the mine site
- Conduct daily safety toolbox talks to maintain the KL Gold safety culture,
- Assist with Emergency Response protocols, scene management, interviews, and obtaining all facts for review by Senior Management,
- Assist with third party's investigation agencies such as Ministry of Labor / Ministry of Environment/ and local and Provincial Police forces as required,
- Ensure compliance to all applicable laws, regulations, policies, and procedures by all site personnel,
- Conduct all related supervisory tasks surrounding emergency response
