Job Title: Specialized First Nation Representative Psychotherapist **Reports To**: Director of Finance and Administration

Position Summary

Reporting to the Director of Finance and Administration (DoFA), the Matachewan First Nation Psychotherapist will provide culturally relevant and trauma-informed psychotherapy services to individuals, youth, families, and groups within the community. This role involves integrating traditional healing practices and clinical approaches to support wellness in a respectful and collaborative manner.

Term: Permanent, Full-Time

Hours of Work: 40 hours per week, Monday – Friday, 8:30AM – 4:30PM, with flexibility to work on weekends and evenings Location: Matachewan First Nation and surrounding areas

Compensation: \$60,000 - \$80,000 annually

Benefits: Employer-paid benefits package and enrollment in pension plan

Start Date: As soon as possible

Areas of Responsibility

- Provide individual, family, and group psychotherapy services, in-person, on the land and/or virtually
- Use culturally safe, client-centered and trauma-informed approaches
- Collaborate with Elders, Knowledge Keepers, and Traditional Healers as appropriate
- Conduct assessments, develop treatment plans, and maintain accurate case notes
- Participate in community wellness initiatives and outreach programs
- Support Crisis intervention and postvention services as needed
- Maintain confidentiality and adhere to professional ethics and standards
- Other related duties as assigned

Requirements

- Master's degree in counselling psychology, Social Work, or related field
- Registration with a recognized regulatory body (e.g., CRPO, OCSWSSW)
- Demonstrated experience working with Indigenous communities
- Strong communication, advocacy, and collaboration skills
- Valid Ontario Class G Driver's license with proof of insurance, access to a vehicle and a clean driver's abstract
- Accepted recent Criminal Record and Vulnerable Sector Check
- Valid First Aid/CPR
