- Install electric cables in the shaft;
- Construct electrical substations in the shaft;
- Complying with all safety policies, procedures and regulations;
- Diagnosing and detecting faults in complex electronic and electrical equipment;
- Assisting in the development, construction and installation of new electrical systems;
- Follow the OHSA acts and regs for mines – Z462 standards;
- Provide support to centralized maintenance team;
- All other duties as may be assigned.
