- Conduct repairs on the vertical mucker bucket
- Maintain and repair jack legs, stoppers, pluggers, and air pumps
- Read and interpret project plans, blueprints and other written instructions and diagrams to perform task at hand
- Perform MIG, TIG, Oxyacetylene and other types of weld based on project needs
- Field install welds, including duct work, light fixtures, vents, fans, metal sheeting and other parts
- Select proper fillers for jobs based on previous experience or project instructions
- All other duties as may be assigned
