COVID-19 Task Team

In light of many recent inquiries about how to access vaccination receipts or records, the NAN COVID-19 Task Team would like to provide the following information:

If you provided an email address at the time of vaccination, you should automatically receive a vaccination receipt by email. If not, please see the two options below for accessing your vaccination receipt.

OPTION 1: All residents

Access your vaccine record directly through Ontario's COVID-19 Vaccination site. This requires internet access and an Ontario health card (the newer version, with a photo): https://covid19.ontariohealth.ca/app-identity?viewId=T4A7644GAWWX

OPTION 2: Residents of remote communities

Community members served by the Sioux Lookout First Nations Health Authority (SLFNHA): Call SLFNHA Health Records at 1-807-737-5196 to request that a copy of your vaccination record be sent to you. The immunization repository is open 8:30 am-12 pm CDT and 1 pm-4:30 pm CDT, Monday through Friday.

Community members served by the Weeneebayko Area Health Authority:

Data entry into the COVID-19 Vaccination Service online portal is ongoing for the WAHA region. Please continue to check the online portal over the next two weeks or contact your local Public Health Unit/Health Centre to inquire about your vaccination record.

If you need your record urgently (within the next 2 weeks) complete the online WAHA COVID-19 Vaccine Receipt Support Survey to request help:
