## **ABOUT THE OPPORTUNITY**

Based at the Timmins Regional Office, we currently have an exciting opportunity for a **Regional Network & Telecom Specialist** to support our Regional IT Team, reporting to the Manager IT Ontario Operations.

The Regional Network & Telecom Specialist will be a support and project focused role where creative thinking, interpersonal skills, and broad technical expertise is required. This individual will have technical ownership for IT and OT networks that span across the entire enterprise, satisfy business requirements, and are highly available. As such the Regional Network & Telecom Specialist must have a broad technical base spanning IT and OT IP network operation, unified communications/VoIP, and monitoring technology and the interconnectivity between them. This individual will also need to have a strong understanding of wireless technology.

## RESPONSIBILITIES

Your responsibilities will include:

- Design, implement, and operate multi-vendor communications and networking equipment including firewalls, routers, switches, wireless access points, WAN accelerators, microwave point-point technologies, provider managed MPLS and NAC.
- Manage all aspects of internal and external IP networks, demonstrating excellent knowledge of IP routing and the supporting protocols (BGP, OSPF, and EIGRP)

- Provide escalation support for the regional communications and wireless infrastructure to a globally distributed team of IT professionals, escalating to vendors when necessary
- Regularly monitor network performance and capacity to ensure equipment and services are functioning and operating at optimal capacity
- Advise local IT staff of outages and problems with the network when required
- Willingness to maintain professional certification levels to meet vendor requirements
- Conduct network test plans, perform testing in labs, and identify technical and operational issues to management.
- Regularly engaged in day-to-day service assurance providing support to all AEM Ontario regional Operations
- Conduct performance-tuning on network hardware/software technology
- Initiate and implement all projects with inclusion of safe and secure practices
- Keep the regional and operations network diagrams up to date with every change
- Provide clear and useful documentation and procedures of support for operations based technicians in order to optimize their work
- Coordinate and execute after hours changes including upgrades, hardware replacements and disruptive changes.
- Advise and support Regional IT staff who are engaged in wireless system upgrades, unified communications/VoIP system upgrades
- Good working knowledge of the day-to-day operating environment, available tools, operating techniques, and end-user applications used with wireless technology (WIFI) and unified communications environments.
- Possess the technical ability to understand, evaluate, and implement unified communications and other collaboration solutions, network and other security solutions and wireless technology
- Maintain regional voice dialing plan and advice when upgrades to regional voice systems is required
- Integrate regional unified communications infrastructure with 3rd party systems used for radio and push
